

## ROP COURSE REVIEW PROCESS



California Education Code 52302 states:

- (a) Every vocational course or program offered by the ROP shall be reviewed every two years by the appropriate governing body to assure that each course or program does all of the following:
  - (1) Meets a documented labor market demand.
  - (2) Does not duplicate other training programs in the area.
  - (3) Is of demonstrated effectiveness as measured by the completion, employment, and postsecondary education enrollment success of its students.
- (b) Every vocational course or program offered by the ROP is reviewed by the ROP Administration every two years to assure that subject matter advisory Committees are established and operational for each approved course.  
(Title 5)
- (c) ROP courses that fail to meet the ROP governing board adopted policies regarding biennial review requirements and standards have been terminated within one year of the biennial review.
